## Old Business:

- Mud Pond Dam Jay
  - -Jay updated Susan Peters on the status of Mud Pond. Roger will need to make sure that the gate is clear of debris.
- Rotary Park Jerry, Jay
  - -Warrant article handout: Jerry and Jay will distribute the handout at town meeting in May, 2021
  - -Jerry and Jay toured the park with Sullivan county forester Dode Gladder. (UNH Cooperative Extension is hiring a new forester for Cheshire County). Dode made suggestions about improvements that could be made to the park. Hemlocks are crowding out other trees cherry, aspen and white birch. The Emerald Ash Borer is in Dublin and will attack and kill the ash trees.
  - -Jerry and Jay will identify a person to do the forest work, in order to improve the park for visitors. Cost estimate: approx. \$3,000.
  - -Grand Monadnock Rotary Grant: Jerry completed the application. Jerry will speak with the group on April 6, 2021.
  - -Property lines: Jay still waiting to hear from Edward Goodrich, the original surveyor. Kate will contact him.
- Separate accounting of funds from land transfers and budget carryovers Katie & Jay -Katie is getting familiar with the spreadsheets.
- Conservation Grants to be investigated Carole, Denise and Katie ongoing

  - -Management of invasives June or July, 2021

These materials reflect extensive work done in 2005, 2006, 2008 and 2010. Wendy will ask Nancy Campbell if she has a copy. Jay will investigate obtaining electronic copies. We do not have the names of current owners of parcels listed in these materials.
- Conservation Easements Public Awareness
